# Youth Education Programs

## Sgt Moses Adams Memorial Middle School Brochure Contest

The contest is to create a tri-fold brochure from a standard 8 ½ by 11-inch piece of paper. The brochure must conform to the contest theme which is one of the five fundamental documents of the United States which you select.

1. Articles of Confederation
2. Declaration of Independence
3. US Constitution
4. Bill of Rights
5. Federalist Papers

The judging criteria will be based on content creativity and correctness drawn personally by the student as opposed to “cut and paste” from books and/or magazines. Computer software tools to create the brochure and artwork is permissible.

Who may enter: All middle school students in public, private, church-based or home schooled in grades 6, 7, 8 or 9<sup>th</sup> (dependent upon the year the American Revolution is being taught). Scouts and Children of the American Revolution (C.A.R.) members in the same age range are also eligible.

Getting Started: A teacher, C.A.R. member or scouting leader will supervise the SAR Brochure Contest.

### Construction Instructions:

1. Brochure Construction: Content should be created by the student and not by a group.
2. Brochure Theme: choose from any of the 5 listed above.



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3. Brochure Size: made from a single 8 ½ by 11 Inch piece of paper folded in manner prescribed by contest rules.
4. Paper thickness & color: Any common paper so long as the final product can be closed as a tri-fold. White paper is the most common.
5. Art work (most important): art work must either be drawn by the student. Tracing is acceptable. Pasting of personally drawn art work is permissible
6. Written text: text is commonly hand written or printed using a computer.

Prizes: Illinois Society Sons of the American Revolution (ILSSAR) - \$300 1<sup>st</sup>; \$200 2<sup>nd</sup>; \$100 3<sup>rd</sup>. The ILSSAR 1<sup>st</sup> place winner will be entered into the National Society Sons of the American Revolution (NSSAR) contest.

Deadline: All submissions need to be received by January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019

### Americanism Elementary School Poster Contest

Who may enter: All students in 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> grades that are in public, private, parochial, or home schooled. Scouts and Children of the American Revolution (C.A.R.) members in the same age range are also eligible.

Themes: The theme of the Poster Contest rotates annually.

- For academic years ending in even numbers (E.g. 2019-2020), the theme shall be “Revolutionary War Event or Events”.
- For academic years ending in odd numbers (E.g. 2018-2019), the theme shall be “Revolutionary War Person or Persons”.
